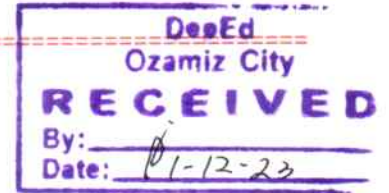

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 23-HFOJ-001
Series of 2023

AN ORDER ADOPTING DEPED ORDER No. 037, s. 2022 OR THE GUIDELINES ON THE CANCELLATION OR SUSPENSION OF CLASSES AND WORK IN SCHOOLS IN THE EVENT OF NATURAL DISASTERS, POWER OUTAGES/POWER INTERRUPTIONS, AND OTHER CALAMITIES

WHEREAS, the Department of Education issued Order No. 037, s. 2022 or the *Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions, and Other Calamities* to further guide schools, its personnel, and learners, both within the public and private institutions;

WHEREAS, Section 455(b)(1)(vii) of the Local Government Code ("Code") provides that for efficient, effective, and economical governance of the city and its inhabitants, the city mayor shall exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the city government and carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities;

WHEREAS, Section 455(b)(2)(iii) of the same Code authorizes the city mayor to enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the city and issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ATTY. HENRY F. OAMINAL, JR., Mayor of the Local Government of Ozamiz City, Province of Misamis Occidental, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the adoption and effective enforcement of Department of Education Order No. 37, s. 2022 in the territorial jurisdiction of Ozamiz City, viz:

SECTION 1. *Cancellation or Suspension in Case of Typhoon.* In-person, online classes, and work from Kindergarten to Grade 12 and Alternative Learning System ("ALS") are automatically cancelled when the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical, and Astronomical Services Administration ("PAGASA") issues Tropical Cyclone Wind Signals ("TCWS") 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 in Ozamiz City.

SECTION 2. *Cancellation or Suspension in Case of Heavy Rainfall.* In-person, online classes, and work from Kindergarten to Grade 12 and ALS are automatically cancelled when PAGASA issues an Orange or Red Rainfall Warning in Ozamiz City.

SECTION 3. *Cancellation or Suspension in Case of Flood.* In-person, online classes, and work from Kindergarten to Grade 12 and ALS are automatically cancelled when PAGASA issues a Flood Warning in Ozamiz City.


SECTION 4. *Cancellation or Suspension in Case of Earthquakes.* In-person, online classes, and work from Kindergarten to Grade 12 and ALS are automatically cancelled when the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology ("PHILVOCS") declares an earthquake with PHILVOCS Earthquake Intensity Scale ("PEIS") V or above in Ozamiz City.

authority to decide on the cancellation or suspension of classes in case of typhoon, heavy rainfall, flood, and earthquake within the territorial jurisdiction of Ozamiz City.
