DIGITAL DEVICE, AND OTHER LEARNING RESOURCES IN
LIGHT OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND OTHER EMERGENCIES**

DATE: January 12, 2023

1. This Joint Memorandum provides information and reiterates policy guidelines of the Department of Education and concerned National Government Agencies (NGAs) on the utilization, useful life, storage, and maintenance of learning resources, including but not limited to self-learning modules (SLMs) and digital devices that were acquired and distributed during the implementation of distance learning in light of the COVID-19 health emergency. Unless otherwise repeated or rescinded by subsequent issuances, these guidelines shall apply to all other learning resources to be procured, acquired, and distributed in the succeeding school years.
2. The SLMs shall remain the primary learning resource for various distance learning delivery modalities and supplementary learning resource for in-person classes from Kindergarten to Senior High School. As ADM modules, the SLMs shall continue to be used by all learners who availed of any of the ADMs so that they can continue learning and finish basic education despite their difficulty in accessing schools. Hence, using quality-assured SLMs procured by field offices in different content and accessible formats remains essential. They shall continue to be utilized by all schools in all grade levels.
