

This fourt Memorandum provides information and reiterares policy guidelines of the Department of Education and concerned National Government Agencies INGAs) on the utilization, useful life, storage, and mountenance of learning resources, including but not limited to self-tearning modules isLMs) and digital devices that were acquired and distributed during the implementation of distance learning in light of the COVID-19 health emergency. Unless otherwise repealed or rescinded by subsequent issuances, these guidelines shall apply to all other learning resources to be procured, acquired, and distributed in the succeeding school years.

The SLMs shall remain the primary learning resource for various distance framing delivery modalities and supplementary learning resource for inperson classes from Kindergarten to Senior High School. As ADM modules, the SLMs shall continue to be used by all learners who availed of any of the ADMs so that they can continue learning and finish basic education despite their difficulty in accessing schools. Hence, using quality-assured ScMs produced by field offices in different content and accessible formats remains essential. They shall continue to be utilized by all schools in all grade levels.
