REITERATING THE DISSEMINATION OF OZAMIZ CITY ORDINANCE NO. 1240-2022 (AN ORDINANCE ENFORCING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND REQUIRING NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES TO SEEK PRIOR CONSULTATION AND APPROVAL FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF OZAMIZ BEFORE THE CONDUCT OF NATIONAL ACTIVITIES, PROJECTS OR PROGRAMS IN OZAMIZ CITY)

- 1. This is to reiterate the dissemination of Ozamiz City Ordinance No. 1240-2022 requiring national government agencies to seek prior consultation with the LGU through the Local Chief Executive (LCE) and thereafter, a resolution from the Sanguniang Panglungsod approving the same.

ORDINANCE NO. 1240-2022

AN ORDINANCE ENFORCING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND REQUIRING NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES TO SEEK PRIOR CONSULTATION AND APPROVAL FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF OZAMIZ BEFORE THE CONDUCT OF NATIONAL ACTIVITES, PROJECTS, OR PROGRAMS IN OZAMIZ CITY

WHEREAS, Section 2 (c) of the Local Government Code requires all national agencies to CONDUCT periodic consultations with appropriate local government units before any project or program is implemented;

WHEREAS, Section 25 (b) of the same Code provides that national agencies and offices with project implementation functions shall coordinate with one another and with the local government unit concerned in the discharge of these functions and shall ensure the participation of local government units both in the planning and implementation of said national projects;

WHEREAS, Section 27 of the same Code provides that no project or program shall be implemented by government authorities unless the consultations mentioned in Section 2 (c) are complied with, and prior approval of the sanggunian concerned is obtained:

WHEREAS, Section 458 of the same Code requires Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact ordinances for the general welfare of the city and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (1) (iii) of the same Code provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall approve ordinances imposing a fine not exceeding Five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) or an imprisonment for a period not exceeding one (1) year, or both in the discretion of the court, for violation of a city ordinance;

WHEREAS, there were instances that some national agencies bypassed prior consultation with the local chief executive and approval from the Sangguniang

WHEREAS, the Body realizes the need to enforce the abovementioned sections of the Local Government Code requiring prior consultation and approval of the Sanggunian;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. SCOPE. This Ordinance shall apply to any activity, project, or program sought to be implemented in Ozamiz City by any and all national government agencies including instrumentalities and government owned and/or controlled corporations (GOCCs) or private entities implementing national government activities, projects or programs.

SECTION 2. REQUISITES. The following requirements shall be observed prior to the implementation of any national government activity, program, or project in this City:

- A) Inform and consult the local chief executive at least fifteen (15) working days before the intended date of activity, program, or project and consider his comments and recommendations about the same;
- B) Conditioned upon endorsement by the local chief executive, secure a resolution from the Sangguniang Panlungsod signifying its approval for the conduct of such national activity, program, or project.

Failure to comply with the abovementioned requisites will render such activity, program, or project unlawful and the city government can immediately prevent the continuance of the same in coordination with law enforcement agencies of the city.

SECTION 3. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES. Strict compliance with the requirements is hereby required, otherwise the City can enforce the following:

- A) The penalty enumerated below shall be imposed upon <u>any and all organizers</u> of such unlawful activity, program, or project:
- 1st offense imprisonment ranging from one (1) month to two (2) months or a fine not exceeding three thousand pesos (P3,000.00), or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court;
- 2nd offense imprisonment ranging from two (2) months and one (1) day to four (4) months or a fine not exceeding four thousand pesos (P4,000.00), or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court;
- iii) 3rd offense imprisonment ranging from four (4) months and one (1) day to one (1) year or a fine not exceeding five thousand pesos (P5,000.00), or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.
- B) The penalty of fine not exceeding three thousand pesos (P3,000.00) each shall be imposed upon any and all participants of the same.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTING CLAUSE. Without prejudice to the 15-day period requirement, the local chief executive upon his discretion, may exempt any national government agency or entity from complying with the foregoing requirements, and allow the conduct its particular activity, program, or project due to necessity and/or urgency of the same.
