## Mechanics, Criteria and Prizes of Laya Cooking Contest

1. There will be 2 categories for the contest one for schools and the other one for food establishments.
2. Participants must be from Ozamiz City with certification of residency from the Barangay.
3. All competitors are requested to wear proper cooking attire.
4. Every team should prepare plates for dish display and served to the judges for testing.
5. Laya for 1 Kilo each participant/group and basic ingredients are provided, however if you have a secret seasoning to put, you can add on.
6. All ingredients are place in front and pick only as yours necessary in cooking recipe.
7. Participants should consist of two (2) members only to avoid the crowd and must maintain health protocols.
8. The participants will be given a total of two (2) hours for preparation and display the final dish presentation.
9. Participants will limit only to 15 Food Establishments with business permit and 20 to School.
10. Each participant will bring in its own table as long as it has a uniform size of 120 cm by 60 cm for the display and cooking.
11. Prizes for food establishments will be in a form of tax incentives.
12. The contest will be on July 15, 2023, 1:00 P.M at Cotta Fort.
13. The decision of the organizing committee and the Board of Judges are final and irrevocable.

4. Participants will be given 5 hours only to finish the painting that may start at 12:00 P.M and end at 5:00 P.M. Contest will be on July 7, 2023.
5. These will be a validation of participants as to the residency. They may bring Barangay Certificate or voter's I.D and School I.D's for students on July 02, 2023, 1:00 P.M at Cotta. Orientation of participants will also be conducted.
6. Deadline of Submission, registration and distribution of members will be on July 5, 2023, 1:00 P.M at Cotta.
