**SUBJECT:** Observance of the National Disaster Resilience Month 2023

Executive Order 29 s. 2017 designates July of each year as the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) throughout the country and mandates the conduct of activities relative to building of disaster resilience covering the four thematic areas: prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, and rehabilitation and recovery.

The annual observance of the NDRM emphasizes the importance of collaboration in addressing the challenges of Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management. For this year, the NDRM theme is "BIDAng Pilipino: Building a Stronger Filipino Well-being towards Disaster Resilience". Coming out of the pandemic, the health emergency emphasized that the most valuable asset in facing such emergency events is the manpower itself. Thus, the NDRM celebration this year aims to focus on ensuring that well-being of every Filipino is well taken care of so that they can efficiently contribute in our effort to build a disaster resilient nation.
