1. In reference to Regional Head Quarter Circular (RHQ) No. 3, s. 2023, dated April 26, 2023, re: 60th Alano Diamond Jubilee Camp Celebration, this Office informs the field on the above-mentioned invitation of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Eastern Mindanao Region with the theme, “HOMEWARD BOUND: Girls’ Reunion and Gratitude Camp,” which will be conducted at Alano Program & Training Center, Toril, Davao City on July 27-31, 2023.
2. Participants to this activity are the Junior and Senior/Cadet Girls Scout with their Troop Leaders who have the following qualifications:
 1. must be registered in GSP Misamis Occidental Council as of June 30, 2023;
 2. must be physically fit with Health Declaration and Examination Form duly signed by the participant and physician;
 3. must have attended a patrol pre-camp training; and
 4. must have 2 chaperons for every 6-8 junior Girl Scouts.
3. There shall be a minimum of 50 delegates per council with no limit to the maximum number of participants.
4. There will be a registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) only, per delegate to cover food, camp souvenirs, fare and entrance during offsite adventures, program and required activity materials, with check payable to GSP Eastern Mindanao Region: BDO Savings Account Name: Girl Scouts of the Philippines Account Number : 003800-0040-32, chargeable against school MOOE, local funds, PTCA funds and other sources subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
5. Teacher-participants to this orientation shall be granted service credits while non-teaching personnel involved shall also be granted Compensatory Time-Off (CTO), re: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Service Credits to Teachers;

OPEN CAMP MECHANICS: FAITH IN MOTION

MECHANICS FOR FAITH IN MOTION

1. The contest is open to all 13 councils of GSP Eastern Mindanao Region.
2. Each contingent should be composed of a minimum of fifty (50) participants including props holders (no male). However, all campers may join if the council has more than 50 delegates. Entry with less than 50 participants will be considered as token presentation.
3. Participants should be official campers of the 60th Alano Diamond Jubilee Camp 2023.
4. Every participating team is required to have a presentation of minimum of five (5) minutes but should not exceed ten (10) minutes to include entrance & exit.
5. The Program Coordinators/management will prepare official timer to take note of the time consumed by each group. Any person brings with them a stopwatch shall not be entertained.
6. Every extra minute of every presentation is a one (1) point deduction from the over-all result.
7. Timer starts as soon as the contingent's name is called.
8. The committee shall prepare 3 flag lets with colors red, yellow & green. Upon calling the name of the team, the green flag shall be raised which means that the time has already started. The yellow flag shall be raised when the time reaches up to five (5) minutes that serve as a warning. And the red flag shall be raised when the time reaches up to ten (10) minutes.
9. Each entry should only have one (1) danceable Christian song. No remix allowed to remain the sincerity and significance of the song. Yells are allowed before or after the start of the song.
10. CD's/USB should be submitted to the Program Coordinators not later than July 27 to avoid delay.
11. The use of props is requisite to the competition because it adds color to the
