2. Participants to this activity are the Junior (Elementary) and Senior/Cadet Girls Scout (Secondary) with their Troop Leaders (Elementary and Secondary Teacher) who have the following qualifications:
 1. must be registered in GSP Misamis Occidental Council as of June 30, 2023;
 2. must be physically fit with Health Declaration and Examination Form duly signed by the participant and physician;
 3. must have parent's consent; and
 4. must have attended the School Based Camping.
3. There shall be a ratio of 8 Scouts is to 1 Troop Leader with no limit to the maximum number of participants.
4. There will be a camp registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (500.00) only, per participant chargeable against school MOOE, local funds, PTCA funds and other sources subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
5. Teacher-participants to this activity shall be granted service credits while non-teaching personnel involved shall also be granted Compensatory Time-Off (CTO), re: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Service Credits to Teachers; DepEd Order No. 84, s. 2003, re: Addendum to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, (Updated Guidelines on Grant of

The Girl Scouts of the Philippines has a significant role in producing remarkable and empowered woman leaders through the realization of the ideals of womanhood and preparation for their responsibilities in the home, the nation, and the world community as recognized by the Department of Education in DepEd Order No. 86 s. 2012 re Guidelines in Revitalizing Girl Scouts in Schools Nationwide.

As a co-curricular program in schools, Girl Scouting offers meaningful opportunities where girls can discuss contemporary issues affecting them and initiate activities that respond to these challenges. The Girl Scouting program helps contribute to the eradication of illiteracy, the achievement of quality education, and social transformation. To achieve the goal of the Department of Education which recognizes the significant role of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Misamis Occidental Council of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines shall conduct the **45th Councilwide Camp on August 9-12, 2023, at Ozamiz City National High School, Ozamiz City Division with the Theme: "HOMEWARD BOUND: Girls' Reunion and Gratitude Camp"**. The participants of this activity are the Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts with their Troop Leaders who are registered in GSP Misamis Occidental Council.

The activity aims to:

- a. develop the five areas of the girl's personality: the physical, intellectual, emotional, social, and spiritual.
- b. develop and experience good and loving relationship with other Girl Scouts and live the spirit of servanthood and responsible leadership.

- c. develop the principles of positive attitude, skills, and habits.

The Camp Registration Fee of each participant (**Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts, Troop Leaders**) is **P500.00** shall be charged against Local Funds/School Board Funds/PTA Funds/MOOE and other source of funds subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

The following are the guidelines and information of the delegates to attend the Encampment.

A. Participants:

- **Junior Girl Scouts (Elementary Pupils)**
- **Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts (High School Students)**
- **Troop Leader (Teacher in Elementary and High School)**
Ratio: 8 Scouts is to 1 Troop Leader shall be observed
No limit as to the number of participants per school/district in each Division.

B. Qualifications:

- **All delegates must be recently registered in the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Misamis Occidental Council.**
- **Must be physically fit with Health Examination form duly signed by the physician and participant.**
- **Must have parents' consent.**
- **Must have attended the School Based Camping.**

 - ✓ **Two (2) candles for Scouts Own and Escoda Ceremony**

Senior Girl Scouts – green and tangerine colored paper
 - ✓ **A gift for adopted child (for Child Care and Babysitter Activity)**

- **Camp uniform for activities and other events**


E. Search for Miss Junior GS 2023 and Miss Senior GS 2023


