 - 2. must be physically fit with Health Declaration and Examination Form duly signed by the participant and physician;
 - 3. must have parent's consent; and
 - 4. must have attended the School Based Camping.
- 3. There shall be a ratio of 8 Scouts is to 1 Troop Leader with no limit to the maximum number of participants.
- 4. There will be a camp registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (500.00) only, per participant chargeable against school MOOE, local funds, PTCA funds and other sources subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. The activity aims to:

a. develop the five areas of the girl's personality: the physical, intellectual, emotional, social, and spiritual.

b. develop and experience good and loving relationship with other Girl Scouts and live the spirit of servanthood and responsible leadership.

c. develop the principles of positive attitude, skills, and habits.

The Camp Registration Fee of each participant (Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts, Troop Leaders) is P500.00 shall be charged against Local Funds/School Board Funds/PTA Funds/MOOE and other source of funds subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

- > Must be physically fit with Health Examination form duly signed by the physician and participant.
