### PREPARATIONS FOR THE 2024 OZAMIZ CITY ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION AND NORTHERN MINDANAO REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION MEETS

- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10588, also known as the Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013 and DepEd Memorandum 005, s. 2023 re: Conduct of the Palarong Pambansa, this Division, in coordination with the Local Government Unit of Ozamiz City, announces the timeline for the conduct of sports activities in preparation for the Ozamiz City Athletic Association (OzCAA) Meet and Northern Mindanao Regional Athletic Association Meet 2024.
- 2. This activity aims to:
  - a. Enhance the physical well-being of students by promoting regular physical activity through sports alongside music and arts education, fostering a balanced curriculum
  - b. Instill positive character traits such as sportsmanship, teamwork, and resilience through participation in sports.
  - c. Support students' social and emotional well-being by providing a positive and inclusive environment for sports participation.
  - d. Promote the correlation between regular physical activity and cognitive function, contributing to improved academic performance.
  - e. Identify athletic talents among students and prepare them for various sports competitions, from Inter-Sportsclub Competitions, Intramurals, Division meets, Regional meets, and up to the prestigious Palarong Pambansa.
- 3. Participation in Physical Education classes and School Sports Club activities is consistent with our Division's commitment to the Equal Opportunity Policy (EOP), as outlined in Divisional Memorandum No. 111-B, 2018. This policy underscores our obligation to create an inclusive environment by prohibiting discrimination based on age, gender, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, or political affiliation.

- 6. All sports activities are scheduled after regular school hours and on weekends to ensure minimal disruption to regular classes. Strict adherence to the no-disruption-of-classes policy shall be maintained.
- 7. Participating schools are mandated to comply with Health and Safety Protocols and the Child Protection Policy, obtain the necessary permits, and ensure the completion of Medical/Physical Fitness Forms and parental consent. This collective commitment will guarantee a safe and conducive environment for the athletes and spectators.
- 8. Cut-off Year for Athlete's Eligibility for SY 2024 City Meet, NMRAA and Palarong Pambansa:
  - a. For an elementary athlete, the cut-off age/year is 13 years old or must have been born on or after January 1, 2011, and
  - b. For a secondary athlete, the cut-off age is 18, or must have been born on or after January 1, 2006. Athletes born before said date shall be immediately disqualified from the Division, Regional, and Palarong Pambansa.

  - b. Certificate of Enrolment and Attendance Completion
  - c. Commiment of Chaperon
  - d. Dental Certificate
  - e. Gallery of Athletes\_FOR ELEMENTARY

  - g. Omnibus Affidavit
