1. Relative to One Asenso Misamis Occidental Provincial Athletic Association Memorandum No. 3, s. 2024, CONDUCT OF LIVE-IN TRAINING FOR ONE ASENSO MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL PROVINCIAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION WINNING ATHLETES, COACHES, CHAPERONS, AND TRAINERS, this Office announces the athletes, coaches, asst. coaches, chaperons, trainers qualified for the NMRAA 2024 (Enclosure 1). Moreover, this Memorandum also presents the divisional guidelines for the conduct of the activity.

c. Transportation

Transportation relative to the conduct of school/station -based in- house training shall be shouldered by the school's MOOE. However, transportation to and from the billeting quarters during the centralized in-house training shall be charged against SEF.

(Note: All expenses relative to the conduct of in-house training are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.)

d. Learning Modality

To ensure learning continuity, flexible learning modalities shall be implemented for the entire duration of the in-house training. (Please refer to # 3, paragraph 1 & 2 of One Asenso Misamis Occidental Provincial Athletic Association Memorandum No. 3, s. 2024, *Arrangement of special classes for athletes*).

School Heads must ensure that classes left behind by the teacher- participants are being attended to and that measures are undertaken to address possible learning gaps, while away from school in compliance with DepEd Order No.9, s 2005 (Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith).

e. Service Credits and CTOs

Teaching personnel who shall render services during the provincial in-house training shall be entitled to service credits. The same number of days for Compensatory Time Off (CTO) shall be granted for teaching-related and non-teaching related personnel in accordance with Joint Circular No.02, series of 2024 issued by the DBM and CSC pursuant to section 1(d) of AO No 103 "Directing the Continued Adoption of Austerity Measures "in the government dated August 31, 2014.

f. Child Protection Policy

All delegations must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s.2012 re: DepEd Child Protection Policy. As such, delegation officials shall be responsible for their student-athlete's protection, welfare, and safety.

3. This Memorandum serves as Travel Authority for all the participants.
4. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.

1. The One Asenso Misamis Occidental Provincial Athletic Association announces the conduct of in-house training, school-based live-in training, and centralized live-in training in preparation for the 2024 Regional Meet to all winning athletes, coaches, chaperons, and trainers **including Saturdays and Sundays, except on March 28-31, 2024 in observance of the Holy Week.**
2. The training schedules and venues are as follows:
 - a. In-house training for the **Athletics** event shall be from **February 19, 2024, to May 2, 2024**, at Misamis Occidental Provincial Athletic Complex (MOPAC);
 - b. School-based live-in training for **other events** shall be from **February 26, 2024, to March 26, 2024**, and;
 - c. Centralized live-in training for **all events** shall be from **March 27, 2024, to May 2, 2024**, at Misamis Occidental Provincial Athletic Complex (MOPAC) except for Swimming (Tangub), Boxing (Baliangao), Pencak Silat, and Para Games (Oroquieta).
3. This in-house, school-based live-in, and centralized live-in training aims to:
 - a. hone and enhance the skills, tactics, and strategies of athletes to improve their performances;
 - b. focus on physical conditioning, strength, flexibility, and overall fitness to ensure the athlete's optimal shape for the competition; and
 - c. educate the athletes on proper warm-up techniques, injury prevention exercises, and safe practices to reduce the risk of injuries during training and

competition.

3. To ensure continuity of learning among student-athletes, they shall have a distance and modular learning alternative with the given provisions and guidelines during the conduct of the said activity attached in Enclosure No. 1.

The arrangement of special classes (modular) for athletes participating in the Training in their respective playing venues shall be facilitated by motivational speakers, teacher coaches, and chaperons and supervised by Team Managers (PSDS). Materials during the special classes shall be taken care of by their respective schools.

4. Attached in Enclosure No. 1 also is the list of athletics technical working committees, qualified athletes, coaches, chaperons, trainers, and the total number of participants per event.

5. All teaching and non-teaching personnel involved in this in-house training, school-based live-in training, and centralized live-in training are entitled to a grant of service credits based on the provision articulated in DepEd Order Under DO 53, s. 2003, re: Revised DepEd Order for Granting Service Credits for Teachers and Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for the School Heads and Non-Teaching Personnel.

6. All delegations must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s.2012 re: DepEd Child Protection Policy. As such, delegation officials shall be responsible for their student-athlete's protection, welfare, and safety.

7. Transportation, meals, and other incidental expenses shall be charged against school MOOE/local funds/SEF subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.

**IN-HOUSE TRAINING, SCHOOL-BASED LIVE-IN TRAINING, AND
CENTRALIZED LIVE-IN TRAINING GUIDELINES**

1. School-based live-in training shall be conducted within the school or specified training venue from February 26 to March 26, 2024.
2. Centralized live in-training is a unified training of all athletes in all events.
3. Transport of athletes to the training venue for centralized training shall be by Division on March 27, 2024. They shall report to the Registration Committee upon arrival at their respective venues.
4. MONHS (Oroquieta City Division) will be the billeting for the Centralized training except for Athletics, Para games, Swimming, Pencak Silat, and Boxing.

PROVISIONS FOR LEARNING CONTINUITY AMONG STUDENT-ATHLETES DURING IN-HOUSE TRAINING (SCHOOL-BASED LIVE-IN AND CENTRALIZED LIVE-IN)

1. The guidelines/agreement must include the grading system of the athletes, how the module shall be distributed and who will supervise the actual teaching-learning delivery.
2. Parents' Consent shall cover all the possible related activities during the conduct of the In-House Training. It shall be submitted in bunches per event to the Camp Directors.
3. Consideration shall be given to the athletes for their grades and absences. They shall deserve the necessary academic support from the school authorities by arranging special classes to ensure that they can cope with their lessons and subject area requirements because they shall be competing and representing their respective schools, Districts, Division, and the Province of Misamis Occidental.
4. The arrangement of special classes (modular) for athletes participating in the In-House Training (school-based and centralized) in their respective playing venues shall be facilitated by the teacher coaches and chaperons and supervised by team managers (PSDS).
5. Materials during the special classes shall be taken care of by their respective schools. School Heads must ensure no disruption of classes per DO 09, s. 2005
6. Only parents or legal guardians (per registration) can get/take/pull out athletes from the venue. A waiver must be signed by the parents/legal guardians before leaving the venue
7. In case an athlete has other co-curricular activities, he or she may opt for one.
8. Gambling, smoking, vaping, and any other illegal acts during the training are prohibited.
9. Coaches, trainers, consultants, Technical Officials, Team Managers, and Technical Directors are encouraged to observe the rules in DO 40, s. 2012 (Child Protection Policy).
10. Psychological first-aid training among coaches, Technical Officials, Team Managers, Technical Directors, and athletes shall be conducted.
11. If there are policies not mentioned can be added anytime during the duration of the training/activity.
