CLUSTERED DISTRICT TRAINING OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ON THE MATATAG CURRICULUM FOR KINDERGARTEN, GRADES 1, 4, AND 7 (K147)

- 1. In accordance with the Unnumbered DepEd Memorandum dated July 2024, issued by the Offices of the Human Resource Development, and Organizational Development and Curriculum and Teaching, this Division will conduct a Clustered District Training of Public School Teachers on the MATATAG Curriculum for Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4, and 7 (K147) on July 22-26, 2024. The venue will be determined by the Public Schools Division Supervisors and school heads involved.
- 2. The primary objective of this training is to equip teachers with the requisite knowledge, skills, and competencies necessary for the effective implementation of the MATATAG curriculum.
- 3. The participants of this training will include the Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4, and 7 teachers from this Division. Facilitators and resource speakers will consist of trained school heads, and select master teachers, and teachers.
- 4. This training will be provided free of charge, funded by the 2024 HRD GAA and HRD Funds. It will include one meal (lunch) and two snacks (morning and afternoon) per day for participants, facilitators, and monitoring personnel, as well as necessary training materials for the five-day duration.
- 5. Participation in this training is in adherence to the Office's implementation of Equal Opportunity Policy (EOP), ensuring inclusivity regardless of age, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, ethnicity, civil status, disability, religion, political affiliation, among others.
