1. In consonance with Regional Memorandum No. 0579, s. 2024 concerning the **PhilHealth Learners' Manual (PLM) Workshop for MAPEH Supervisors and MAPEH Grade 8 Teachers**, this Division is scheduled to send participants to the said event on September 11, 2024, at Costa del Sol Resort Hotel, Magsaysay Street, Lower Loboc, Oroquieta City.
2. The workshop aims to:

  - c. foster collaboration among educators and supervisors to integrate the manual into pedagogical practices.
3. Given the recent commencement of classes on August 29, 2024, the participants for this training shall comprise the MAPEH Education Program Supervisor and 14 school leaders (as detailed in the enclosed document) representing the ten districts instead of the MAPEH Grade 8 teachers to prevent any disruption of classroom activities.
4. PhilHealth will provide one morning snack, lunch, and one afternoon snack for all the participants while travel expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.



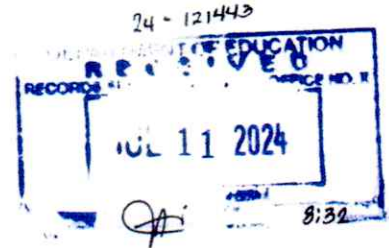

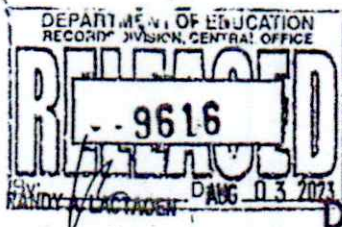
