OBSERVANCE OF FILIPINO VALUES MONTH

1. Relative to Proclamation No. 479 dated October 7, 1994, the Month of November has been declared as Filipino Values Month that aims to promote greater consciousness of values that are uniquely and positively Filipino, love of God and country, strong family ties, care and respect for elders, diligence, patience, loyalty, hospitality, bayanihan, generosity, regard for personal honor, and dignity.

2. The theme for this year, ***"Pagsusulong ng Bagong Pilipinas: Ang Kabataan Bilang Pundasyon ng Pagbabago"*** highlights the essential role of the youth in driving national progress, urging them to lead with Filipino values and actively shape a more inclusive and transformative future for the Philippines.

3. During the month-long observance, all schools are encouraged to integrate the Filipino values not only in Values Education/Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) subject but in all other learning areas.

4. The following are the suggested activities aside from values integration in the class:

- Family Day
- Discussion of Filipino Values during flag raising ceremony
- Filipino Values Workshops
- Poster and Slogan Contest
- Essay Writing Contest
- Youth Leadership Forum or Seminar
- Values-Based Film Showing and Discussion
- Social Media Campaign
- Cultural Performance and Exhibits



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5. School heads are requested to make the necessary arrangements to ensure compliance with the no-disruption-of-classes policy as outlined in DepEd Order No. 9, Series of 2005, titled *"Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith."*
6. All expenses related to the celebration will be charged to the school's MOOE/local funds, in accordance with existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is also emphasized that no financial burdens should be imposed on learners or parents.
