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5. Transportation relative to the conduct of school/station -based and in- house training shall be shouldered by the school's MOOE. However, transportation to and from the training venues shall be shouldered by this Division.
6. To ensure learning continuity, flexible learning modalities shall be implemented for the entire duration of the in-house training.
7. School Heads must ensure that classes left behind by the teacher- participants are being attended to and that measures are undertaken to address possible learning gaps, while away from school in compliance with DepEd Order No.9, s 2005 (Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith).
8. Teaching personnel who shall render services during holidays and weekends for the school-based and in-house training shall be entitled to service credits. The same number of days for Compensatory Time Off (CTO) shall be granted for teaching-related and non-teaching related personnel in accordance with Joint Circular No.02, series of 2024 issued by the DBM and CSC pursuant to section 1(d) of AO No 103 "Directing the Continued Adoption of Austerity Measures "in the government dated August 31, 2014.
9. All delegations must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s.2012 re: DepEd Child Protection Policy. As such, delegation officials shall be responsible for their student-athlete's protection, welfare, and safety.
10. All other provisions shall remain in effect.
11. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
