**INTENSIVE SPORTS IN-HOUSE TRAINING IN PREPARATION FOR THE 2025
NORTHERN MINDANAO REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (NMRAA) MEET**

All Others Concerned
1. In preparation for the upcoming **Northern Mindanao Regional Athletic Association (NMRAA) Meet**, this Office announces the conduct of the **Intensive Sports In-House Training** on February 7, 2025, to March 25, 2025, in three (3) separate venues: Oroquieta City, Jimenez, Tangub City.
 2. This training activity aims to:
 - a. promote the holistic development of learners through the provision of intensive training to improve their physical, intellectual, and social well-being;
 - b. level up the competition strategies and allow the body to gradually build up strength and endurance;
 - c. improve skills and build motivation, ambition, and confidence to go for the best result in the competition; and
 - d. gain more knowledge of their sports as well as enable them to learn about the importance of having a healthy mind and body.
 3. The DepEd Child Protection Policy (DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012) shall be fully adopted and implemented during and after sporting events. The in-house training shall follow the safeguarding guidelines to minimize risk, guarantee safe space, and ensure a positive experience for all delegates, organizers, and others who are involved in the event. Furthermore, through the safeguarding guidelines, appropriate preventive, protective, and remedial measures will be properly implemented. A Child Protection Desk shall be fully operationalized through the Child Protection Committee (CPC) in all playing venues and billeting quarters.
 4. The Technical Working Group will hold an orientation on Child Protection and House Rules to all the camp members after settling on Day 1.
 5. The class schedules of the teacher-coaches, teacher-trainers, and other teachers participating in this intensive training will be arranged by their respective school heads to guarantee continuity of learning. Similarly, all student-athletes at their various training facilities will have modular classes facilitated by the Academic Managers. The Academic Managers are expected to submit their class program, competencies covered, and assessment records of every athlete-learner to their respective advisers. Materials during the special classes shall be taken care of by the school heads of the athletes.
 6. The Disaster Risk Reduction Members (DRRM) shall prepare a comprehensive contingency plan for the duration of the event and identify the dates for the conduct of hazard drill orientation and its implementation especially in the billeting quarters and playing venues. Moreover, the existing DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022 titled "New Guidelines on the

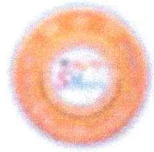

HOUSE RULES

1. Observe *self-discipline* and *zero waste management*.
2. Always maintain a *courteous, obedient, polite and cooperative conduct* inside the camp and playing venues.
3. Vandalism, smoking, gambling, drinking liquor is strictly prohibited in the camp.
4. Maintain cleanliness inside and outside the camp as well as the playing venues. Garbage must be placed in the proper receptacles.
5. Observe curfew hours (8:00 PM - 4:00 AM) Coaches/chaperons/athletes are prohibited from going out of the camp during this time.
6. Socializing among athletes and officials is strictly prohibited.
7. No parents or visitors are allowed to sleep in the quarters.
8. Observe gender sensitivity. Male coaches /trainers will sleep with the boys and female coaches with the girls.
9. Coaches/chaperons must manage the use of cellphones of athletes especially during night time and account all athletes before sleeping.
10. Coaches and chaperons must eat together with their athletes during the designated meal time. Wearing of sleeveless shirts and too shorts, shorts in the mess hall, especially during meal time is strictly prohibited.
11. Use comfort rooms, bathrooms, urinals, sinks and wash stations.
12. Close quarter properly, put off lights, faucets, fans, and other devices before leaving the quarters.
13. Don't leave valuables such as watches, money, jewelry, cell phones, etc... in the quarter.
14. Officials are discouraged to make "man Fridays" of their athletes.
15. In circumstances that athlete/s must leave the camp other than playing venues, coach / chaperons must accompany the athlete/s and properly log in the logbook.
16. In case of problems that may arise in some circumstances, see the Camp Prefect and Management Committee.
17. Coaches/chaperons, officials must clean and organize their quarters to promote orderliness and wholesome atmosphere.
18. All athletes and officials are expected to follow all the provisions of DepEd Order governing this Palaro.
19. House Rules may be amended if necessary.

NOTE: Violation to any of these house rules is subject to disciplinary action.
