

CONDUCT OF DAILY CLEAN-UP DRIVES IN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors (CID and SGOD)
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
This Division

1. In line with the Ozamiz City's campaign against dengue and in support of maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment, all public schools under the Division of Ozamiz City are hereby directed to conduct daily clean-up drives/activities to eliminate possible mosquito-breeding sites within school premises.
2. School Heads shall take the lead to engage and involve teachers, non-teaching personnel, learners, parents including barangay and other stakeholders. Teachers and learners shall practice proper waste disposal and maintain cleanliness in their school surroundings.
3. Teachers are also directed to monitor daily health condition of learners particularly the learners' temperature.
4. Schools shall document and submit daily with photos to the assigned platform on Partnerships. Full cooperation is expected to ensure the success of this initiative. Together, let us work towards a dengue-free school environment for our learners.
5. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this Memorandum is desired.

SUBJECT: STRICT IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF
"ABKD" - AKSYON BARANGAY KONTRA DENGUE AND
THE "5S STRATEGY"

As of 23 February 2025, a total of 154 dengue-related cases have been reported to the City Health Office ("CHO"). In view of the alarming increase in dengue-related cases, all Punong Barangays are directed to strictly implement and enforce the following directives:

- 1.) The "ABKD" - Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue - a daily clean-up drive of the barangay to prevent and eradicate dengue cases;
- 2.) The "5S Strategy" - Search and Destroy Mosquito Breeding Sites in your area, Self-Protection from Mosquito Bites, Seek Early Consultation when signs and symptoms of dengue occur, Support Fogging, and Sustain Hydration;
- 3.) Daily Search and Destroy operations of mosquito breeding sites in all Barangays such as stagnant pools of water, canals, water ways, and/or drains;
- 4.) Support fogging activities conducted by the CHO every Mondays to Fridays especially in areas with active cases. Punong Barangays are directed to request for fogging and net to cover open water containers from the CHO through their hotline number 09125614121.

Barangays are likewise enjoined to communicate, cooperate, and coordinate with the CHO for the conduct of larval survey in their area.

Considering that most of the victims of dengue-related deaths are children, Punong Barangays are ordered to coordinate with the different schools, whether public or private, in your jurisdiction to conduct Search and Destroy Operations and support fogging activities to ensure that schools are dengue-free.

Immediate implementation and compliance are enjoined. Daily posting, no later than 3 PM, of the documentation of compliance with this Memorandum is strictly required.

Failure to comply with the directives in this memorandum, including the documentation requirement, may give rise to administrative and criminal liability.
