PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST THE SPREAD OF HAND, FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE (HFMD) IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

This Division

- 1. In view of the recent increase in reported cases of Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD) among school-aged children in the province and the guidance from the Department of Health (DOH) and the Provincial Health Office, all public schools are hereby directed to strengthen the implementation of preventive and control measures to minimize the risk of transmission within school settings.
- 2. To ensure the health and safety of learners, teaching and non-teaching staff in the schools, the following preventive measures must be observed and followed:

a. Promote Proper Hygiene and Sanitation

- o Ensure that learners wash their hands with soap and clean water regularly, especially before meals and after using the toilet.
- Promote cough and sneeze etiquette (e.g., using a tissue or the elbow to cover mouth/nose).
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands, especially your eyes, nose and mouth.
- o Ensure availability of hand soap and alcohol based sanitizers.

b. Classroom Hygiene Monitoring

- Clean and disinfect high-touch surfaces (e.g., desks, doorknobs, toys, comfort rooms and learning materials) 2 – 3 times daily.
- Use a bleach solution (1 tablespoon of bleach per 1 liter of water) for effective disinfection.

c. Monitor and Report Cases

- Conduct visual screening of pupils/students for signs of fever, rashes on hands/feet, and mouth sores.
- Report suspected cases to the School Health Personnel or the nearest health facility.

d. Health Education and Awareness

- o Integrate short discussions on HFMD prevention during class homeroom or health periods.
- Display DOH IEC materials on HFMD in visible areas (classrooms, bulletin boards). Download IEC materials from this site https://bit.ly/HFM_IEC.

e. Immediate Isolation and Referral

- Learners showing symptoms must be sent home and referred to a health facility for assessment.
- o Parents/guardians must be contacted for immediate pickup.
- o Reinforce a no-class policy for symptomatic students until fully recovered.

f. Parent and Guardian Engagement

- Disseminate HFMD information through Parent-Teacher Associations
 (PTAs), daily reminders via group chats or bulletin boards.
- O Symptoms to watch for at home and importance of keeping sick children at home.

g. Weekly Monitoring

- All schools are enjoined to submit a brief weekly report on HFMD surveillance, preventive measures taken, and any referrals made, beginning June 27, 2025, every Friday before 3:00 PM, through google forms, https://bit.ly/HFMD_Weekly.
- 3. The participation of the learners and school personnel in this activity is in adherence to the principles of equal opportunity for continuous improvement that there is no discrimination on account of age, gender, civil status, disability, religion, political affiliation, medical conditions among others.
