These competitions provide an excellent platform for students to showcase their talents, engage in intellectual challenges, and gain recognition for their achievements.



A. What is the NATIONAL MATHLETICS COMPETITION?

- I. The **2nd NATIONAL MATHLETICS COMPETITION** is an online national Mathematics competition open to all students enrolled in the Philippines from Grade 3 to Grade 12. It has a clear mission focused on enhancing students' intellectual abilities, particularly in mathematical, logical, and computational skills.
- II. A **strong and stable internet connection** is required during the competition.

III. MINIMUM REQUIREMENT ON EQUIPMENT/GADGET/IT RESOURCES

- (1). Laptop with camera/audio with high-speed internet connectivity, OR
- (2). Desktop computer (with digicam and audio) with high-speed internet Connectivity; OR
- (3). 2 mobile phones with internet connection (1 for online test and 1 for zoom), OR
- (4). Desktop computer (with internet) and mobile phone.

B. Format

There will be a 30-item multiple-choice test lasting for 1 hour. Each item is worth 5 points, making the highest possible score 150 points.

Students can be categorized according to their grade level for the school year 2025-2026. Only students who are enrolled in the Philippines can join the competition.

Level 1 – Grade 3 & Grade 4

Level 2 – Grade 5 & Grade 6

Level 3 – Grade 7 & Grade 8

A. What is the NATIONAL LINGUISTICS COMPETITION?

- I. The **2nd National Linguistics Challenge** is an online competition open to all students from Grade 3 to Grade 12 who are officially enrolled in schools across the Philippines for the school year 2025-2026. The competition aims to enhance and showcase the English language skills of participants, fostering a deeper understanding and mastery of linguistic concepts, grammar, vocabulary, and reading comprehension.
- II. A **strong and stable internet connection** is required during the competition.
- III. **MINIMUM REQUIREMENT ON EQUIPMENT/GADGET/IT RESOURCES**
 - (1). Laptop with camera/audio with high-speed internet connectivity, OR
 - (2). Desktop computer (with digicam and audio) with high-speed internet Connectivity;
OR
 - (3). 2 mobile phones with internet connection (1 for online test and 1 for zoom), OR
 - (4). Desktop computer (with internet) and mobile phone.

B. FORMAT

There will be a 30-item multiple choice type of question good for 45 minutes. Each item is worth 5 points, making the highest possible score 150 points.

Students can be categorized according to their grade level for the school year 2025-2026. Only students who are enrolled in the Philippines can join the competition.

C. TOPICS COVERED

The topics covered in the program encompass several areas essential for language development and literacy.

Vocabulary includes lessons on synonyms, antonyms, context clues, and idiomatic expressions to enhance word knowledge and usage.

Language instruction focuses on subject-verb agreement, prepositions, conjunctions, conjunctive adverbs, verb tenses, the order of adjectives, proper use of punctuation, pronouns and their antecedents, parallelism or parallel structures, direct and reported speech, and figures of speech to build grammatical accuracy and stylistic effectiveness.

Reading comprehension skills are developed through activities on making inferences, identifying the main idea and supporting details, summarizing, and determining the tone and mood of passages.

Additionally, **spelling** is emphasized for Grades 3 and 4, helping young learners achieve accuracy in written communication.

A. What is the NATIONAL SCIENTIFIC CHALLENGE (NSC)?

- I. The **2nd NATIONAL SCIENTIFIC CHALLENGE (NSC)** is an online competition open to all students from Grade 3 to Grade 12 who are officially enrolled in schools across the Philippines for the school year 2025-2026. The competition aims to enhance and showcase students' scientific ability, critical thinking skills, problem-solving skills, and overall knowledge in science. It provides a platform for students to apply scientific concepts and analyze data.
- II. A strong and stable internet connection is required during the competition.
- III. **MINIMUM REQUIREMENT ON EQUIPMENT/GADGET/IT RESOURCES**
 - (1). Laptop with camera/audio with high-speed internet connectivity, OR
 - (2). Desktop computer (with digicam and audio) with high-speed internet Connectivity; OR
 - (3). 2 mobile phones with internet connection (1 for online test and 1 for zoom), OR
 - (4). Desktop computer (with internet) and mobile phone.

B. FORMAT

There will be a 30-item multiple choice type of question good for 45 minutes. Each item is worth 5 points, making the highest possible score 150 points.

C. TOPICS COVERED

The topics covered encompass several areas essential for scientific literacy and understanding.

Biology includes lessons on cell structure and function, genetics, ecosystems, human anatomy and physiology, and biodiversity to develop knowledge of living organisms and their interactions.

Chemistry focuses on atomic structure, chemical bonding, states of matter, chemical reactions, the periodic table, and solutions to build a strong foundation in matter and its properties.

Physics covers motion and forces, energy transformation, waves and sound, electricity and magnetism, and simple machines to enhance comprehension of physical principles and their real-world applications.

Environmental Science explores ecosystems, conservation, climate change, pollution, and sustainable development to promote awareness of environmental issues and responsible stewardship.

Astronomy delves into celestial bodies, the solar system, stars and galaxies, space exploration, and cosmology to cultivate curiosity about the universe and our place in it.
