OFFICIAL GUIDELINES

I. Participant Eligibility

1. The competition is open to all Senior High School students currently enrolled in the Accountancy, Business, and Management (ABM) Strand within Ozamiz City.
2. Each participating school must send a team consisting of three (3) Senior High School students enrolled in ABM Strand as participants with their respective coach.

II. Scope and Coverage

Questions will be based on the official Department of Education (DepEd) ABM Curriculum, including but not limited to:

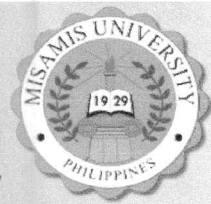
- Fundamentals of ABM 1 & 2
- Business Math and Finance
- Organization and Management
- Principles of Marketing
- Applied Economics

III. Mechanics of the Competition

The quiz bowl is divided into three main rounds, plus tie-breaker rounds if necessary.

Round	No. of Questions	Type	Time Limit	Points
Easy	10	Multiple Choice	10 Seconds	2 pts
Average	10	Mixed (MC/Solving)	20 Seconds	3 pts
Difficult	5	Problem Solving	30 Seconds	5 pts
DoD*	1	Advanced Solving	1 Minute	10 pts

*DoD = Do or Die Round



General Rules:

1. **Reading of Questions:** All questions will be read aloud by the quizmaster twice and simultaneously flashed on the screen.
2. **Answering Time:** The countdown begins only after the quizmaster has finished reading the question for the second time and says "Go."
3. **Materials:** Participants will be provided with a whiteboard and a marker. No external calculators or scratch papers are allowed unless provided by the organizers.
4. **Submission:** Participants must raise their whiteboards immediately when the timer expires. Boards raised late will not be considered.
5. **Clincher Round:** In the event of a tie for the top three spots, a Clincher Round consisting of 3 questions (30 seconds each, 5 points each) will be conducted.

V. Protests and Conduct

1. Any protest regarding a question or an answer must be raised by the participant before the next question is read. The board of judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
2. Coaching from the audience is strictly prohibited and may result in the disqualification of the school's representative.
